



Hillel at Stanford Alcohol Use Policy

Events at the Hillel premises:

If alcohol is available at events taking place at Hillel at Stanford facilities, the following policies must be adhered to:

- The event has been explicitly advertised for participants that are 21+,
- There is a way to identify the age of the student,
- There is a security mechanism that can check to insure there is no underage drinking occurring,
- There is a security mechanism that can determine there is no over drinking occurring,
- The location of the event is separate from students who are under 21 (upstairs or in a separate building),
- EANABs available (Equally Attractive Non-Alcoholic Beverages).
- There is NO known drinking and driving,
- There is NO known other illicit drug use occurring,
- There are NO other abuses occurring as a result of drinking

If an event occurs where alcohol is being served and some participants may be under the legal drinking age of 21, event organizers must adhere to the following:

- Screen all students by seeing their IDs before being poured alcohol,
- Insure alcohol drinks are not shared with others.
